Pepin County Fair Camping Rules & Regulations:

These camping rules were established to provide a safe and respectful environment for campers at the Pepin County Fair as well as to provide necessary information for the Fair in case of an emergency.

1. 4-H, FFA, and other youth group exhibitors and their families are the only eligible members to register and stay overnight in the Pepin County Fair Camping site. There is a maximum of eight campers per lot.
2. Each lot must have an adult who is responsible for all persons and equipment in the camping lot. The adult must stay overnight in the camping area each night of the fair. The adult must be 21 years of age or older.
3. Camping lots will be roped off by Pepin County Fair staff. Only one camper and/or tent is allowed per camping lot. Lots are only available Friday, July 21, 2017 and Saturday, July 22, 2017.
4. These are primitive camp sites with no electricity. Portable toilets are available. Water may be used from the fair barn.
5. All garbage is to be disposed of in provided dumpsters on fairgrounds. Camping lots are to be kept clean of trash/rubbish at all times.
6. Open fires are not permitted, unless previously arranged and approved by fair personnel.
7. Use or possession of intoxicants, narcotics, illegal drugs, or use of vulgarity is prohibited.
8. No one is permitted to possess or consume any controlled substance or alcoholic beverage in any public or private place in the State of Wisconsin.
9. The Pepin County Fair assumes no responsibility for damage or injuries to campers.
10. There is a 12:00 midnight quiet-time rule in effect at the camping area. Campsites will need to have all loud music off and keep conversations low at this time.
11. Fair Board members, Fair Staff, and/or Law Enforcement have the authority to close and evacuate any camping lot as they deem necessary.
12. Noncompliance with these rules and regulations could result in the disqualification of exhibitor's and forfeiture of all contracts, ribbons, awards and/or premiums.
